

# IMPACT of the Dietary Supplement Industry California



## ECONOMIC IMPACT

In California, the dietary supplement industry has a total direct economic impact of \$15.9 billion.



## JOBS

The dietary supplement industry provides more than 46,100 high quality jobs in the state of California and is responsible for another 57,653 related jobs.



## WAGES

The dietary supplement industry and ingredient suppliers pay \$3.9 billion in employee wages each year in California. These are good paying jobs with an average wage of \$84,900 per year.



## STATE IMPACT

Dietary supplement manufacturers and ingredient suppliers operate throughout the State of California. The industry provides 103,772 total jobs, paying \$8.9 billion in wages, and has an overall economic impact of \$31.1 billion.



## DIETARY SUPPLEMENTS

Dietary supplement products include vitamins, minerals, herbs and botanicals, amino-acids, sports nutrition supplements, weight management products and specialty supplements. These products are intended to be used as supplements to, not substitutes for, a well-balanced diet and a healthy lifestyle. When used properly, they help promote overall good health and prevent disease. More than 180 million Americans take dietary supplements annually.
